

NOTES REGARDING CONTACTS WHO OWN OR ARE
 KNOWLEDGABLE ABOUT DUMILE FENI'S ART

1. Eric Estorick - Owner of Grosvenor Gallery, 48 S. Moulton Street, London, W1, England - 44-1-629-0891
 Handled Dumile's work in late 60's; has many drawings, several small sculptures; is knowledgeable of others in both Europe and South Africa who know his art. Eric has published at least one major book on ^{European} ~~African~~ art (in 1938). He believes Dumile is the "very best artist from South Africa within the last 20 years." He would be pleased to show any prospect the works he has on hand and discuss his workmanship.
2. Lucy Jarvis - President, Creative Projects, Inc., 45 Rockefeller Plaza, 541-7776. She owns several of Dumile's drawings (one very large piece hangs in her apartment; another is in her office.) She is also a collector and knows of others who are familiar with Dumile's work. She believes Dumile's work is extraordinary and would be happy to talk with any interested prospect and lend her works to an exhibition any time.
3. John Povey - ^{and heads an African Art project;} Professor of English, UCLA, knows or perhaps has an important bronze statue of a "Baby"; is knowledgeable of others who have some of Dumile's works. John also publishes, (or did publish) a magazine titled "African Arts." (He has not yet been contacted).
4. Art Oternberg - (Husband of Liz Claybourne; can be reached through her 41st and Broadway office). He owns a black flat matte bronze statue titled "Louis Armstrong" which he apparently keeps in his New York City office. (He has not been contacted).
5. Anthony Quinn - Actor, currently starring on Broadway in Zorba, owns a 4 foot bronze head, which he keeps in his house in Spain. (However, the house is not staffed when he is not there). His secretary is Gabriella Passeretti, 744-1800. ^{Quinn made no other comment)}
6. Mary McFadden - Designer (Mary McFadden, Inc., 264 W. 35th Street, 736-4078). Owns several drawings and maybe some sculpture. She is a collector and has knowledge of others who are knowledgeable of Dumile's works. (Her secretary was reached but Mary was out of town).
7. Clyve Manell - He is a wealthy collector, who owns a bronze "Mother and Child." He is currently living in South Africa. His son Ricky Manell lives on Broadway and Spring Street (home-483-6665; office 966-7157). (He is not been contacted.)
